**THE TANA RIVER COUNTY FLAGS AND EMBLEMS  
(AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) ACT, 2022**

**AN ACT of the County Assembly of Tana River to amend the Tana River County Flags and Emblems Act, 2015**

**ENACTED** by the County Assembly of Tana River, as follows—

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Tana River County Flags and Emblems (Amendment) ((No. 2) Act, 2022.

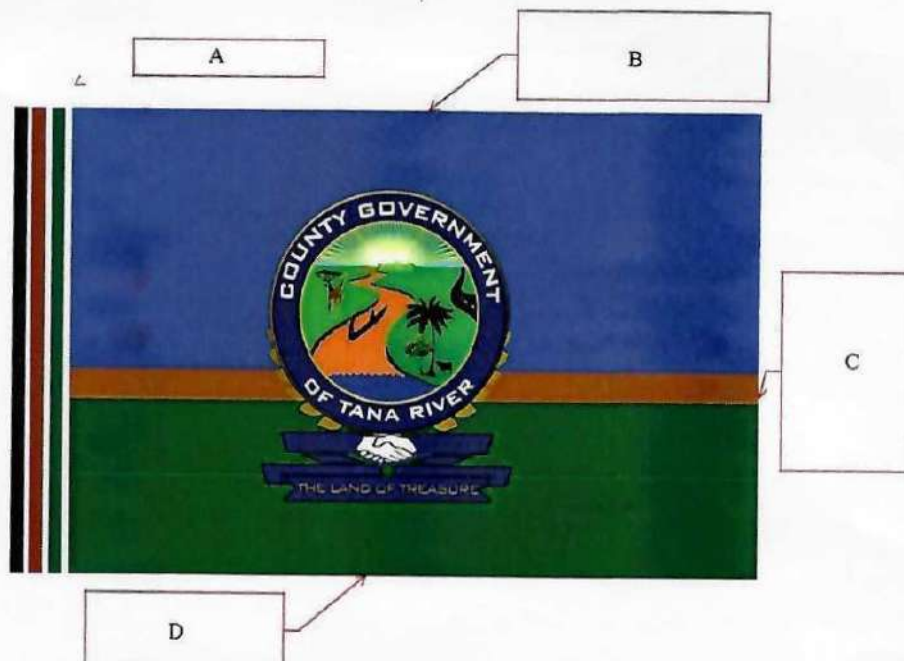
**Substitution of the First Schedule of Act No. 3 of 2015**

2. The Tana River County Flags and Emblems Act, 2015, hereinafter referred to as the “Principal Act”, is amended by deleting the First Schedule and substituting therefor the following new First Schedule.

**FIRST SCHEDULE**

*(Section 1)*

**THE FLAG OF TANA RIVER COUNTY**



**A: Strips of our national flag-** depicting our nationality

**B: Marine Blue** - Symbolizes Blue Economy which is one of our economic pillars that relates to the sustainable use of the water resource for economic excellence

**C: The brown strip**-Depicting the typical color of the River Tana which influences the major economic pillars of our county and the economic livelihoods of our people.

**D: Green** - Symbolizes our rich fertile land and agriculture in our county which is another economic pillar of our county.

### Substitution of the Second Schedule of Act No. 3 of 2015

3. The Principal Act is amended by deleting the Second Schedule and substituting therefor the following new Second Schedule.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

(Section 2)

### EMBLEM (COURT OF ARMS)



**A:** The county's slogan having much of resources to exploit for economic excellence.

**B: Cereal Wreaths** – Symbolizes plenty of produce in our county and strength of our people in surviving through the natural environmental extremes.

**C: Canoe and passenger** - depicts the leaders paddling upstream towards the vision with the passenger depicting the subjects being taken to the vision of the county. It is a symbol of power, wisdom, authority and integrity of our leadership towards achieving our county's vision.

**D: Giraffe** - to symbolize tourism as one of our economic pillars.

**E: *Vegetation and Greenland*** - depicts our rich variety of vegetation cover and the deep fertile soils in our county.

**F: *Vision***- the vision of our county in the near future.

**G: *River Tana***- The Iconic River Tana Strikes a balance in the livelihoods of our county. It is a natural resource that has influence on the locals livelihoods and nature in our county.

**H: *Infrastructure*** – symbolizes our county's development agendas for the future among the core being urbanization.

**I: *Cattle, Mango and palm trees*** - Symbolizes both crop and animal farming with the palm tree symbolizing our coastal economic block and culture.

**J: *The ocean strip***- This being one of the economic pillars of the county (blue economy).

**K: *Handshake*** - Advocates for the peaceful coexistence of our people in the county despite the diverse cultural composition.
