THE TANA RIVER COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2024

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Tana River to provide for the imposition or variation of cess, fees or charges for permit, licences or services and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Tana River, as follows—

PART I — PRELIMINARY

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Tana River County Finance Act, 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, —

“authorised channel” means making payment to the County through an officer appointed by the County to collect revenue or through any other mode of payment as may be prescribed by the County;

“Cess” means fees charged for goods;

“County” means County Government of Tana River;

“fair location” means a place which has a medium rate of development due to limited availability;

“far away location” means places characterised by demographic challenges where the inhabitants are most sparsely populated and social amenities cannot be accessed with ease;

“far from fair location” refers to places which at least start growing and have resources that when utilised and developed can make growth and are sparsely populated areas;

“prime location” refers to a place which has a high rate of development due to abundant availability of resources e.g. cities and municipalities.
